HEIMLICH MANEUVER, Part 1

Heimlich (ihīmlik) maneuver is the manual application of sudden upward pressure on the upper abdomen on a choking victim to force a foreign object from the trachea. Heimlich maneuver is therefore a life-saving emergency response. It is a simple technique that will dislodge, remove or expel food or choking object from a person's windpipe or airway. It is done by increasing pressure in the abdomen and chest. Pressure enables the object to be expelled.

If you notice any of these signs on a person: choking, making a gesture for help, cannot breathe or showing loud and difficult breathing, unable to speak, inability to cough effectively, blue or gray color of lips and the fingernail beds, and loss of consciousness, perform the Heimlich maneuver. Do these steps:

1. Approach the person who needs your help. Signal to him that you will perform the Heimlich maneuver.

2. Stand with your legs separated to support your body and maintain balance.



3. Gently wrap your arms around the waist of the choking victim.

4. Slightly lean forward.

5. Make a fist with one hand. It does not matter which hand.

6. Position your hands below the rib cage but above the navel.

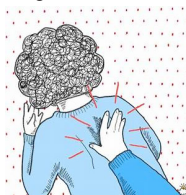
7. Wrap your other hand around your fist.

8. Make series of thrusts on the abdomen by pulling inward and upward. It should feel like pulling up the person. Make thrusts quick and forceful.



9. Make five successive thrusts. If the food or object is not dislodged, apply five more.

10. Perform back blows if the object is not dislodged. Deliver five back blows with the use of the heel of your hand. Aim for the area between the shoulder blades.



11. Call for emergency service if object is not expelled. Stay away from the choking person once the emergency service arrives.

GLOBAL RECESSION SPARES PHILIPPINES - VILLEGAS

Economic Outlook bleak: World economic turmoil within 18 months to 24 months

Globalization brings advantages as well as challenges to worldwide economies. According to Dr Bernie Villegas, renowned economist in the Philippines, he foresees a slowdown in trade and industrial activities in most parts of the world causing reduction in Gross Domestic Product in most countries. He predicts that recession will set in anywhere from 18-24 months from now. He cited the worsening economic relations between China and the United States, Brexit and European Union, slowdown of Russian economy and other western countries, Japan and South Korea destabilization due to dependence on these giant economies. Very critical input in his analysis is the aging population of Japan and South Korea causing them to balance their macroeconomic objectives against social responsibilities toward an elderly population and a declining fertility rate in their respective countries which lead to less productivity.

His bold prediction was that the Philippines will not be affected by the recession. Good news from his proclamation and he stated the following reasons as his rationale:

1. The Philippine economy is not heavily affected by foreign investment and agriculture;
2. The Philippines has the best Central Bank in Asia;
3. The Philippines has a young emerging market;
4. The Philippines has an English speaking population, preferred in international hiring, hence, translating to foreign earnings from overseas workers remittances;

5. The Philippine population is better educated and healthy.

These factors contribute to the resilience of the Philippine economy against recession. The Philippines must, however, protect itself from negative social behaviors or economic growth dampeners such as low agricultural productivity. Presently, the Philippines is self reliant on food production and therefore, does not have to import food supply for its population. Dr. Villegas enumerated other dampeners:

▮ Obstacles in doing business in the country. The example cited is investment capitalization disparity between foreign investors and Filipinos. This must be reviewed and replaced.

▮ Shortage of technological skill. Philippines must remain in-step with technological advancement.

▮ High frequency of natural calamity. Rehabilitation of disaster areas can be very expensive for government and a tremendous loss for an otherwise productive community.

▮ High rates of electricity increases production cost

▮ Corruption in government

Dr. Villegas stressed positive economic opportunities in the Philippines due to being the fastest rising emerging market, having a younger, highly literate population and a government initiative balancing economic relations between prosperous ASEAN neighbors.

ELECTION ADVISORY

September 2, 2019

Dear Fellow Rotarians:

As provided for in our amended Bylaws, we shall have the election of the Board of Directors for Rotary Year 2020-2021 on **September 26, 2018 during our regular Thursday meeting.**

To ensure a level playing field, all candidates shall not engage or participate in any partisan activities or campaigning that gives undue advantage to candidates. The votes shall be based on the merits of every candidate so as to maintain and enhance the club's prestige and high standing in the community.

Here are a few guidelines regarding the elections:

1. In order for the elections to be valid, a quorum consisting of **"one third of the membership"** which is equivalent to 76 members should be present and have voted;
2. To be eligible to vote, a member should have paid at least the 1st semester's membership dues and centennial seed fund by September 24, 2019. On the other hand, candidates should have paid the full year's membership dues and Centennial Seed fund on or before September 24, 2019 in order to be voted upon;

The official list of members eligible to vote shall be released by the secretariat on September 25, 2019.

3. Candidates must have at least one year residency in Rotary Club of Manila at the time of nomination, otherwise the nominee will automatically be disqualified;
4. Members are required to vote for no less than 5 candidates. Ballots with less than 5 votes will be automatically nullified;
5. Electors will have to write the Full Name or Rotary Name with Surname of the candidates of choice over the spaces provided for in the Ballot.
6. The results of the elections will be announced immediately after the canvassing of the votes.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ELECTION ON THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 26, 2019

- STEP 1:** REGISTER YOUR ATTENDANCE WITH THE SECRETARIAT
- STEP 2:** MEMBERS IN THE QUALIFIED VOTERS LIST WILL BE ISSUED AN **ELECTION STUB**
- STEP 3:** THE **ELECTION STUB** SHOULD BE PRESENTED TO THE COMELEC REPRESENTATIVE AT THE DESIGNATED POLLING PLACE IN EXCHANGE FOR THE BALLOT
- STEP 4:** MEMBER SHOULD FILL-UP THE BALLOTS BY VOTING NO LESS THAN FIVE (5) CANDIDATES

3. Penalty for electioneering shall be disqualification in case the candidate subject of such protest is the winning candidate.

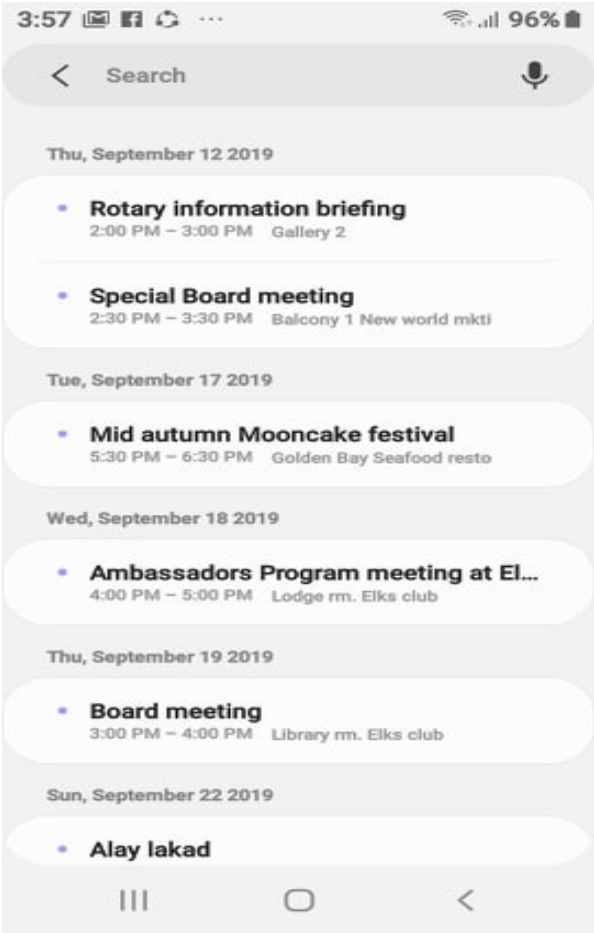

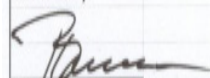
