Heimlich Maneuver on a lying down victim

1. If the choking person has fallen, get him lie on his back. Kneel on the person's hips. Get on your knees and position yourself on top of the person.

2. Place your hand on top of the other. Place the heel of your hand on top of the

choking person's abdomen. This area is just below the rib cage but above the navel.

3. Place your hand on the person's abdomen. Don't bend your elbows. Put your weight on him with a slight upward motion. Repeat doing thrusts until the object is expelled from the person's mouth.



4. When the object is dislodged, pull person's head to the side and remove the object from his mouth.

Heimlich maneuver on a choking baby

When you noticed an infant or a baby who has choked or has difficulty of breathing, perform Heimlich maneuver. Hold the infant's face down. Make sure the infant's head is turned so that he can breathe. Kneel near the infant's feet. Give the baby five quick blows to the back but do not use harsh force. Do not press too hard as this could hurt the infant. Gravity with quick blows to the infant's Back is enough to expel the object. Keep the head of the choking infant lower than his feet. Remove the object when you see it. Call for help if the object does not come out.

ELECTION ADVISORY

September 2, 2019

Dear Fellow Rotarians:

As provided for in our amended Bylaws, we shall have the election of the Board of Directors for Rotary Year 2020-2021 on **September 26, 2018 during our regular Thursday meeting.**

To ensure a level playing field, all candidates shall not engage or participate in any partisan activities or campaigning that gives undue advantage to candidates. The votes shall be based on the merits of every candidate so as to maintain and enhance the club's prestige and high standing in the community.

Here are a few guidelines regarding the elections:

1. In order for the elections to be valid, a quorum consisting of **"one third of the membership"** which is equivalent to 76 members should be present and have voted;
2. To be eligible to vote, a member should have paid at least the 1st semester's membership dues and centennial seed fund by September 24, 2019. On the other hand, candidates should have paid the full year's membership dues and Centennial Seed fund on or before September 24, 2019 in order to be voted upon;

The official list of members eligible to vote shall be released by the secretariat on September 25, 2019.

3. Candidates must have at least one year residency in Rotary Club of Manila at the time of nomination, otherwise the nominee will automatically be disqualified;
4. Members are required to vote for no less than 5 candidates. Ballots with less than 5 votes will be automatically nullified;
5. Electors will have to write the Full Name or Rotary Name with Surname of the candidates of choice over the spaces provided for in the Ballot.
6. The results of the elections will be announced immediately after the canvassing of the votes.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ELECTION ON THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 26, 2019

STEP 1: REGISTER YOUR ATTENDANCE WITH THE SECRETARIAT

STEP 2: MEMBERS IN THE QUALIFIED VOTERS LIST WILL BE ISSUED AN **ELECTION STUB**

STEP 3: THE **ELECTION STUB** SHOULD BE PRESENTED TO THE COMELEC REPRESENTATIVE AT THE DESIGNATED POLLING PLACE IN EXCHANGE FOR THE BALLOT

STEP 4: MEMBER SHOULD FILL-UP THE BALLOTS BY VOTING NO LESS THAN FIVE (5) CANDIDATES

STEP 5: MEMBER WILL DROP HIS BALLOT PERSONALLY INTO THE BALLOT BOX.

EARLY VOTING starts at 11:00 A.M. and will be closed by 1:00 P.M.

We therefore reiterate our appeal to those who have not paid their membership dues to please settle this on or before Sept. 24, 2019 to qualify you to vote in the scheduled elections.

Further, we encourage everyone to be present on Sept. 26, 2019 and allow your voices to be heard in so far as electing the leaders of our club is concerned.
