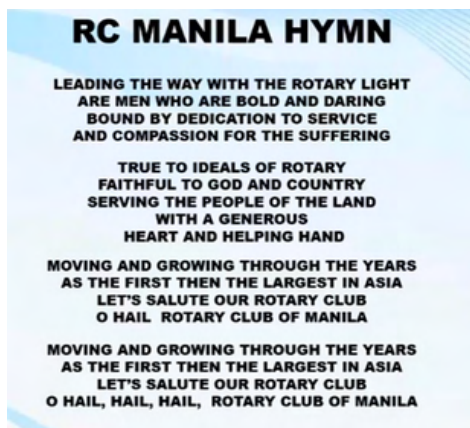

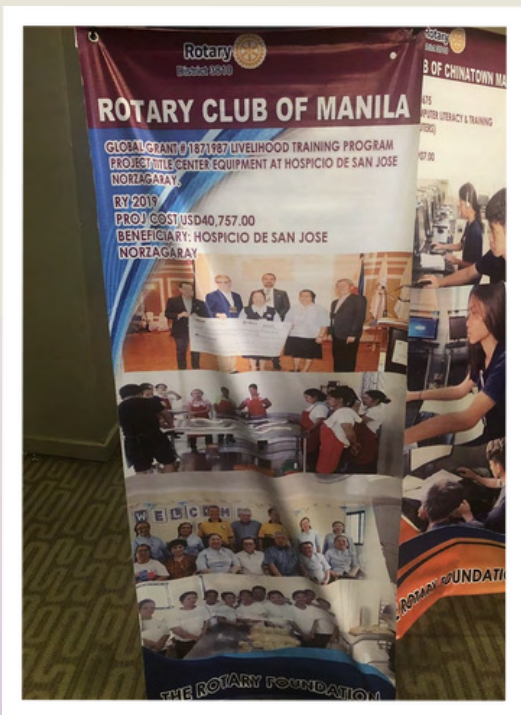

I must confess, I didn't set out to find Rotary. Rotary found me. I became involved in Rotary through a series of fortunate events which has changed the way I look at everything.

When I was 13, I volunteered for the Red Cross and that experience led me years later to create a project to establish a first-aid station in my high school. At my graduation ceremony, I was surprised with an award from the local Rotary club for my volunteer work with the Red Cross. The award was in honor of one of my teachers, who passed away unexpectedly. Receiving the award and knowing that my teacher had appreciated my efforts gave me more inspiration to keep volunteering.

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Some years later, while I was studying to complete a law degree, I saw a poster for Rotaract. I was excited to get involved with the organization that played a role in my passion to help others. Together with a couple of my friends, we founded the first Rotaract club in my Chilean town. And it was my honor to serve as the club's charter president. When I was later elected as a District Rotaract representative, my goal was to increase Rotaract's visibility in my district. That year, we generated a 60% percent increase in membership and succeeded in launching several new clubs.

In 2018, I was honored to serve on the Rotaract-Interact Committee of Rotary International. I wanted to be close to the members I represented, so I reached out to as many Rotaract members and Interact members as I could from around the world to hear their stories and learn about their concerns. Based on some of their feedback, the committee proposed to the RI Board several ideas to strengthen the ability of Rotaractors to participate fully in Rotary. The Board accepted our recommendations. The result was a proposal to the 2019 Council on Legislation to elevate the status of Rotaract to that of a membership type.

In the weeks leading up to the Council, I used social media to explain the benefits of Rotaract being elevated to membership status and why it was urgent that we enact it. When the Council voted to approve our proposal, I was invited to be on the Rotaract Committee and the Elevate Rotaract Task Force in 2019-20. We were responsible for advising the Board on how to implement the provisions of the enactment and establish a "new era of Rotaract." It was exciting to serve with outstanding leaders worldwide, all dedicated to enhancing the experience of Rotaractors.

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After the Board accepted our recommendations, our task force began to inform both members of Rotary and Rotaract of the changes. But then the COVID-19 pandemic hit creating a challenge for us to raise awareness.

But through virtual platforms, I engaged with more than 400 clubs in 100 districts in 10 regions of the world, sharing strategies on how Rotaractors and Rotarians can work closely together that is mutually beneficial.

Last year, aided by two good friends, we created a mentoring program involving district governors-elect who were under the age of 45. I am a strong believer that any organization needs to listen to young leaders because they bring a fresh perspective.

As I was in the final stages of studying for the BAR exam, I accepted an invitation to serve as a Rotaract advisor on the planning committee for the 2023 Rotary International Convention in Melbourne, Australia. It's a unique opportunity to share my experiences and help create an incredible event for the family of Rotary. I am delighted to serve as part of Rotary International President-elect Jennifer Jones' team. She is my role model and the kind of Rotarian that I strive to be. She invited me to the 2021 International Assembly, where I shared my story with other future leaders.

Receiving the Service Above Self Award last year was an incredible honor. I am so happy we are in a time when Rotaractors can be recognized for the contributions they are making in Rotary and in their communities. We are not the future of Rotary; we are the present. And it's time to serve together.

OUR PRESUMPTIVE SPEAKER.

“We hope to not only heal the nation but also heal the economy. These are the top priority programs of the majority in the incoming administration. And the key element here, of course, is unity.” — Rep. Martin Romualdez

Leyte First District Representative and House Majority leader FERDINAND MARTIN ROMUALDEZ, like many Manila Rotarians who have assumed leadership in the highest echelons of our government, is the presumptive choice to be elected as Speaker of the House in the 19th Congress, which will make him the 31st speaker in an illustrious line of leaders that headed our national legislative assembly since 1898. Under his leadership, the lower chamber is poised to prioritize measures to get the country out of the COVID-19 pandemic and sustain its economic recovery.

Born as the third child of Benjamin “Kokoy” Romualdez and Juliette Gomez, he belongs to an influential and affluent clan. His father, Benjamin, served as the Governor of Leyte and was appointed as the ambassador to the United States, China and Saudi Arabia. He is also the nephew of former first lady Imelda Romualdez Marcos and late Filipino president Ferdinand Marcos. His cousins, Bongbong and Imee Marcos are also active in politics today with the former overwhelmingly elected as the next Philippine president and the latter serving as Senator.

Rep. Martin attended Cornell University in the United States from 1981 to 1985, graduating with a Bachelor of Arts degree in government. In 1988, he earned a

Certificate of Special Studies in Administration and Management from Harvard University. He later enrolled at the University of the Philippines, College of Law in 1988, where he became a member of the Upsilon Sigma Phi fraternity. He eventually earned his Bachelor of Laws degree in 1992.

Immediately after earning his law degree, he began to serve as concurrent trustee and president of Doña Remedios Trinidad Romualdez Medical and Dr. Vicente Orestes Romualdez Educational Foundation. In 1995, he started work as director and legal counsel for the CARPA Realty Development Corporation, and as trustee for Remedios Trinidad Romualdez Medical Foundation. Before his work in his family's foundations, he spent a considerable time in the banking field. He was Chairman of the Board for Equitable PCI Bank, as well as Director for several companies, among them Philippine Commercial International Bank, Equitable Card Network, EBC Investments, Inc., Equitable Savings Bank, PCI Leasing Corporation, and PCI Capital Corporation. The family also owns the renowned Metro Manila broadsheet Manila Standard, the Journal Group of Publications, and the mass media firm Philippine Collective Media Corporation. He is also the National President of the Lakas-Christian Muslim Democrats party.

A University of the Philippines-educated lawyer, Rep. Martin was first elected to the post of House majority leader in 2016 as part of a term-sharing deal for Speaker

between Taguig City Rep. Alan Peter S. Cayetano and Marinduque Rep. Lord Allan Jay Q. Velasco. In 2019, he ran under the Lakas Party as Congressman in the First District of Leyte, defeating Lino Dumas of the Partido Federal ng Pilipinas (PFP). As Representative, he authored bills that focused on overseas Filipino workers, laborers, health among many others. During his first stint in Congress, he has authored 325 bills, co-authored 60 more, and was elected Majority Leader on the House Committee on Rules.

House leaders and prominent members expressed support to Rep. Martin for the House Speakership largely because of his legislative prowess, his mastery of the legislative grind, and his reputation as a consensus builder. Many believe that he will be a vital cog as the incoming administration fulfills its vision of unity and prosperity for the country. Certainly, the 19th Congress under the leadership of a Speaker Martin Romualdez will augur well in the passage of important and crucial legislative reforms for the country and the Filipino people under the incoming administration.

Of course, the Rotary Club of Manila is expected to throw its full support to one of its own. Speaker Romualdez will definitely bring the House of Representatives to new and greater heights under a common goal of unity towards economic and moral recovery, social justice and the rule of law.
