These valuable collaborations will not only benefit our club and local community but also expand our impact across the globe as we work hand-in-hand with fellow Rotarians.

Upon my return, I look forward to sharing my experiences with you and discussing the lessons, ideas, and insights gathered during the two DISCONs.

In the meantime, I am happy to share with you the events and activities of the past week.

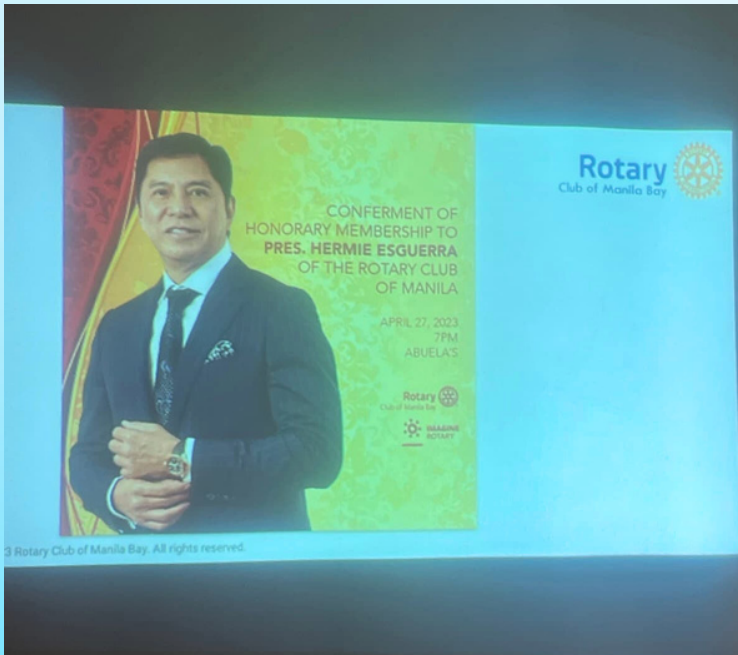
Conferment of My Honorary Membership to RC Manila Bay

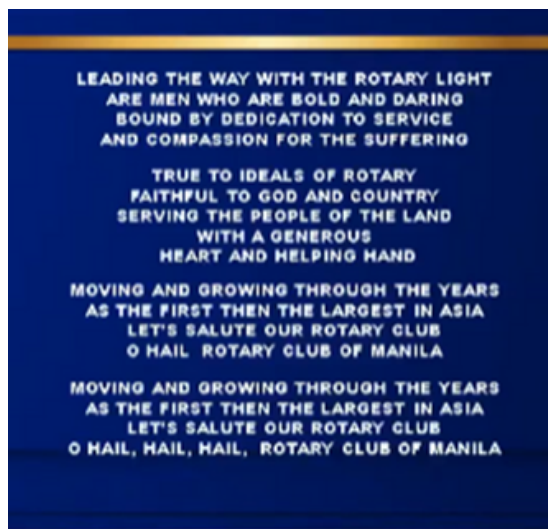


STAR Rtn. Paul Koh led the recitation of the Rotarian Pledge.
