Doc Tony is currently serving as the Representative of Malasakit@Bayanihan Partylist which garnered close to 400,000 votes in the most recent elections last May 2022.

Dr. Anthony Golez Jr. or “Doc Tony” for many who know him is championing healthcare reforms in the country and leading the advancement of Disaster Risk Reduction Management systems as well in the 19th Congress (2022-2025). Doc Tony was the Representative of the Lone District of Bacolod City in the 15th Congress of the House of Representatives of the Republic of the Philippines in 2010.

In today’s congress, he has already principally authored SIX House Bills which became Republic Acts already, 60 Bills in the Third Reading, 27 pending House Bills and 15 House Resolutions filed already. He is the Senior Vice Chairperson of the Committee on Health and Vice Chairperson of the Committee on Disaster Resilience, and with memberships on the different powerful Committees on Appropriation, Legislative Franchise, Energy, Accounts, National Defense and Security, Trade and Industry, Nuclear Energy, and Interparliamentary Relations.

Prior to 2022 elections, he was the President/CEO of Filipinas Tectonic Safety Systems Corporation that exclusively distributes disaster risk management technologies from different countries (2014-2022) and Adjunct Professor at the Asian Institute of Management (2019-2021) for the Executive Masters on Disaster Risk and Crisis Management Program at AIM Makati.

Doc Tony Golez, prior to 2010 elections was also involved in working with the government bureaucracy as **the Senior Deputy Press Secretary and the Deputy Presidential Spokesperson** of Her Excellency Gloria Macapagal Arroyo in 2007. As such, he advised her Excellency on all matters pertaining to presidential and government communications planning and strategy, while at the same time being one of her Excellency’s spokespersons. He was one of the longest serving spokesperson of the President in the government.

In 2004, Doc Tony was the **Deputy administrator of the office of Civil Defense (OCD) Department of National Defense** and the **official government Spokesperson of the National Disaster Coordinating Council (NDCC)**. It was during his stint in the OCD-NDCC did he garner both national and international recognition because of the disaster management reforms he has done to make our country safer from disasters (both man-made and natural), and at the same time decreased dramatically the annual casualty count brought about by timely government preparation, advise and warning to affected communities. He was also educated in **Bioterrorism** and **Crisis Management** being a recipient of numerous trainings he underwent in the United States as a scholar of the US State Department and attended trainings and lectures at Pacific Command Pearl Harbor Hawaii, Pentagon-Washington and Federal Emergency Management Agency-FEMA.

In Oct 2007, Doc Tony was named as one of The Outstanding Young Men (TOYM) of the Philippines in the field of Disaster Management, a category that was opened for the first time in TOYM history to honor Dr. Golez's service to the country.

In 2002, he entered the Department of Health as the Executive Assistant of Secretary Manuel Dayrit. He was involved with policy-making, strategic analysis and implementation of the different health programs of the Department. He was well versed with the health agency's bureaucracy having been working with the different bureaus to including the bureau of Food and Drug (BFAD and now FDA) and the Phil Health.

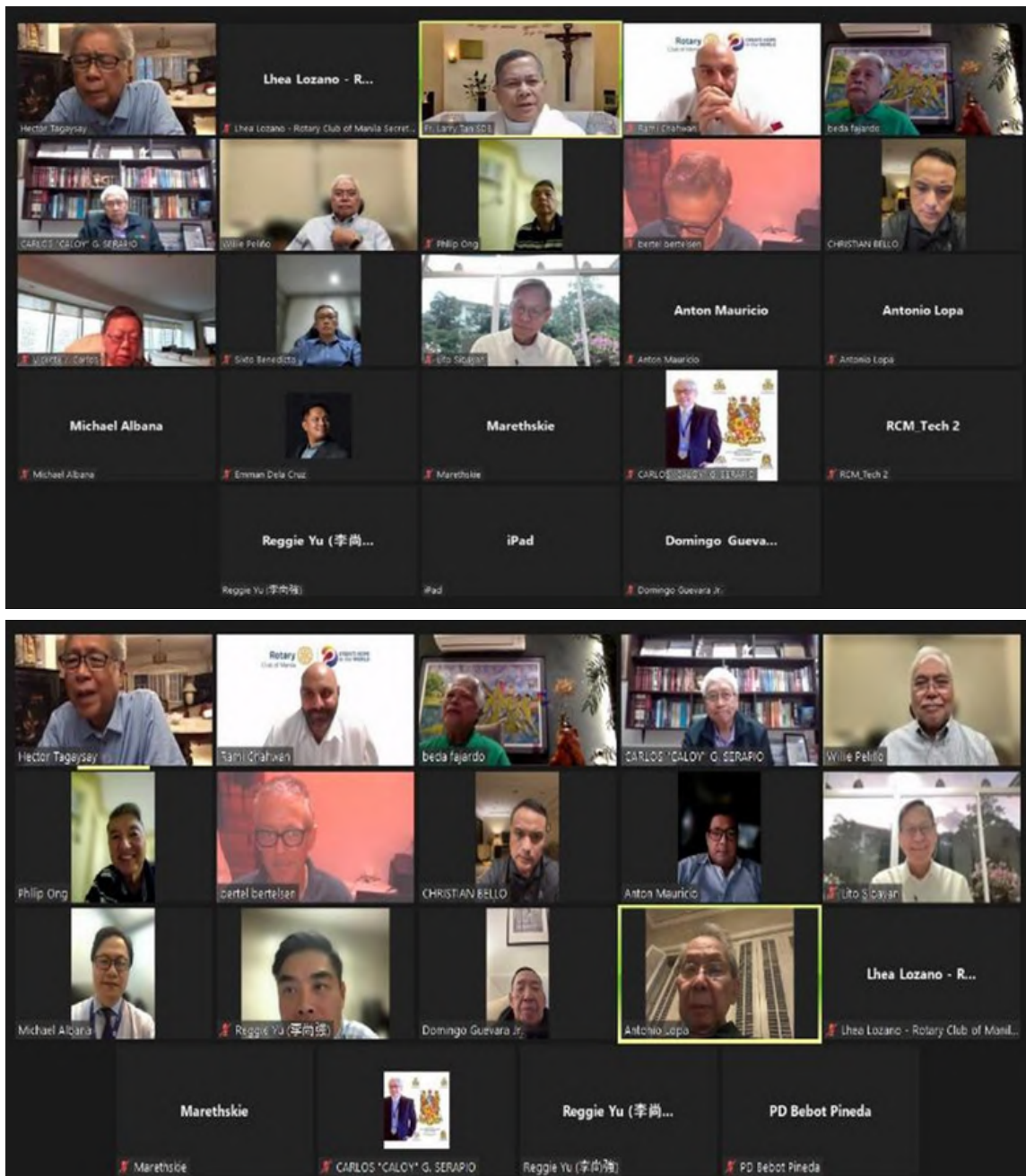
